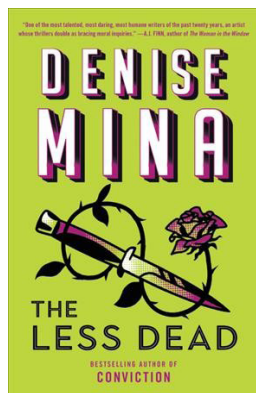

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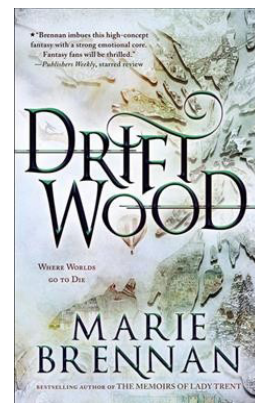
❑ **The Less Dead by Denise Mina**

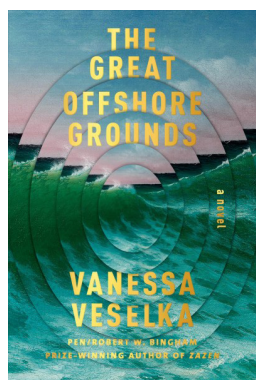
❑ **Driftwood by Marie Brennan**

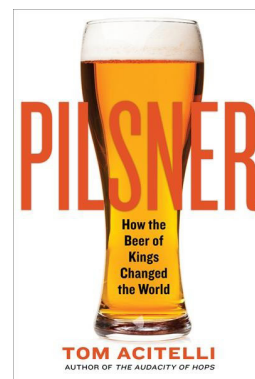
❑ **The Great Offshore Grounds by Vanessa Veselka**

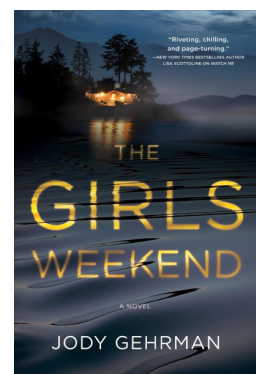
❑ **Pilsner: How the Beer of Kings Changed the World by Tom Acitelli**
